# 9 Graduation Credits

- Currently require 28 credits
- In the past 4 years, we have NOT had one student who failed to graduate due to credit deficiency
- In the past 4 years, all 9th grade students have earned the required number of credits
- Many students graduate with 32+ credits -college credits included
- Heavily determined by Hathaway Requirements

o 4,4,4,3,4 +19 +2PE



# Early Graduation Rates

- Currently we have 1 early graduate this year. Typically we will see a student use this option every other year.
- Contributing factors: career advancement, military service and college acceptance
- Early graduation is restricted due to staffing and limited sections of English courses offered in the school.





# Early Release

- This is only offered to seniors who are on track to graduate and have satisfactory grades.
- Typically 80% or better of our student take an early release for work or for personal time
- Typically Seniors have maxed out their elective offerings in the fields that they prefer



# P.E. Requirements

01 We have 1 PE teacher K-12 and currently offer two courses of 9th and 10th grade PE to meet District requirements

02 All students must take 9th and 10th grade PE



03 Students have the option for lifetime fitness as an elective



# Benefits of 24 vs 28

- Fewer credits to earn as a Freshman
- Allows for scheduling options to be opened up (Little Snake River example)
- The district could choose to put expectations on students for future career and success planning
- In Junior and Senior year students could have options for Job Shadow, and internships (This depends upon district expectations)





## Drawbacks of 24 vs 28

- Unless the district places emphasis on elective programming priorities we could lose programming
- Fewer elective exploration opportunities
- More partial programming could occur
- Could reduce ADM by students selecting online for convenience (less electives means less draw)
